

General Information

1. Fort Benning, Georgia is located just outside of Columbus, Georgia, a city with a population of 140,000 people. It is approximately 100 miles southwest of Atlanta, Georgia. Fort Benning is the Home of the Infantry for the United States Army.

Student Arrival/Departure:

(1) Airport. Students traveling to Fort Benning by air must fly into the Columbus, Georgia Metropolitan Airport. This usually requires the student to change flights in the Atlanta International Airport. Students must ensure they are ticketed all the way through to the Columbus Metro Airport. An International Student Training Detachment (ISTD), representative will meet students at the Columbus Airport. Students must inform ISTD of the arrival time, date, and flight number. Students should make every attempt to arrive during normal duty hours: Monday-Friday, 0800 to 1700 hours. Students should notify ISTD of any changes in the flight itinerary. After duty hours, inform the Brigade Staff Duty Officer of any changes. There is also a Military Liaison Office located in the Columbus Airport to assist students with any problems. (2) Privately Owned Vehicle. Students arriving to Fort Benning by Privately Owned Vehicle should report to ISTD, Building 399, Olson Hall during duty hours. After duty hours, students report to the billeting desk at Olson Hall for room assignments and then report to ISTD, in uniform, the next working day at 0800 hours





Course Description / Administration / Remarks:

Provides personnel representing purchaser and recipient countries and foreign national employees of SAOs an opportunity to study current US policies, procedures, and rules, as they apply to the security assistance program. The course is tailored to present the significant aspects of the Foreign Military Sales program, highlighting the management concerns of purchaser and recipient countries. Overall objectives of the course are to increase understanding of the total security assistance program and the individual manager's responsibilities. In the long run, effectiveness in communicating with the US supporting agencies will be improved, thus enhancing the efficiency of overall security assistance management.

Quarters and Messing Facilities. 1. All VOQ reservations will be made by the DISAM Registrar. Reservations for all students will be made at the VOQ office, Bldg 825, Area A, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB). Current VOQ rate is \$8. A limited number of VOQ suites are available for colonels and above at a rate of \$14. Not all VOQ accommodations at WPAFB have private baths. Personnel in grades of Lt Col or GM-14 and below may be assigned to a private room with a connecting bath to another room. We realize this may be inconvenient, but the availability of quarters and high level of demand for TDY bed space make this situation a necessity. 2. There are no government messing facilities at WPAFB for officer personnel. Use of Officers Open Mess facilities is available to all military officers, civilian students, industry students, and retired officers serving in DoD positions, if they belong to an open mess or officers club at their own installation. Students may use the officers club dining facilities if residing in the VOQ. A field ration mess is available for all enlisted personnel in the Kittyhawk area. Membership in the NCO Open Mess is available to all enlisted and civilian personnel at a cost of \$7 per month. Club cards from home stations are honored. A cafeteria located in Bldg 127 (directly adjacent to DISAM) serves breakfast and lunch on weekdays. B. Local Transportation. DISAM foreign students will be met at the airport when arrival times are provided to DISAM. C. DD Form 1556 and Student
